### Application Guidelines for Domestic (U.S.) Citizens

- Bachelor's or master's degree in MIS/IS/CS/CE or closely related field
- GPA of 3.0 or better at an undergraduate level
- Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) score of 600, or Graduate Records Examination (GRE) score of 1200 (Quantitative 700), or better.
- Statement of Purpose and three letters of recommendation

### Application Guidelines for International Students

- Bachelor's or master's degree in MIS/IS/CS/CE or closely related area
- Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) score of 600, or Graduate Records Examination (GRE) score of 1200 (Quantitative 700), or better.
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score of 570 (paper) or 88 (IBT) or better, or IELTS 7.0 or better
- Statement of Purpose and three letters of recommendation
